MAINSRING COMMONS

\$1,500,000

A gift of \$1.5 million will lead the campaign and impact the community for years to come. This lasting legacy includes the opportunity to tie the donor's name to the property. The campus at 22 Shapleigh Road will host multiple non-profit and social service partners, collectively supporting community members throughout the seacoast.

In addition, a plaque will be prominently featured on the exterior of the building at all three entrances: Fair Tide's Thrift Store, Footprints' Market, and Mainspring social service offices.

SUSTAINABILITY SPONSOR

\$1,000,000

From energy-efficient windows to solar arrays and green roofs, Mainspring's sustainable design decreases our environmental impact while reducing overhead costs. Given the disproportionate impact that climate change has on individuals with low incomes, these features of the Mainspring project protect the clients who will utilize our services.

MAINSRING WING

\$500,000

The Mainspring entrance, located on the East side of the building, will be the primary entryway to many of Mainspring's programs and services. Our goal is for anyone who walks through the doors to feel welcomed and assured that they have come to the right place. Individuals who visit Mainspring will have the opportunity to access a wide variety of services available to meet their needs. This space will be light-filled, airy, and calm - providing a physical and emotional break from the stressors and elements that many individuals carry with them.

FOOTPRINTS MARKET

\$250,000

Footprints is moving towards a market-model shopping experience for our community. The Market will offer a grocery-style shopping experience providing individuals a more dignified manner to accessing food and allowing children to feel like they are shopping at a "regular" grocery store. Footprints will expand their nutrition security program with a focus on quality proteins, produce and dairy products.

Recognition OPPORTUNITIES

FAIR TIDE THRIFT STORE

\$250,000

Fair Tide's Thrift Store serves as a critical source of sustainable funding for the agency's forward progress. Additionally, the store provides low-cost clothing and household items to the entire Seacoast community. For agency clients, the thrift store is able to offer integral items such as winter gear, or kitchenware for a new home, at no cost. The thrift store provides a connection point between Fair Tide and the community which elevates the importance of creating a beautiful and customer-friendly store design. The new thrift store will have more space, a vastly improved layout, and an easy and accessible donation drop-off system, which will increase sales and, ultimately further Fair Tide's work in the community.

FOOTPRINTS COMMISSARY KITCHEN

\$100,000

The Footprints Kitchen will be a fully-equipped commissary kitchen that will allow for a wide range of educational programming, cooking/nutrition classes and food preparation. Footprints will offer a variety of pre-made meals with our own food label detailing ingredients as well as dietary restrictions and allergen information. The kitchen will also give Footprints the ability to create samples of our weekly "meal kit", allowing individuals to taste a recipe prior to shopping for the ingredients necessary to cook that meal at home. This will offer exposure to a wider variety of foods and expand interest in the cost-effective strategies of cooking at home.

MAINSRING GREETING / WAITING AREA

\$75,000

Our goal is to provide a welcoming and comfortable atmosphere for any individual who walks through the doors at Mainspring. To achieve this goal, the greeting/waiting area will convey a sense of ease, relaxation and well-being. We want each individual experience to be positive so there is never a hesitation to visit the Mainspring facility. Every Mainspring guest will be greeted by a receptionist who is knowledgeable about the agencies and resources available so they can be directed appropriately.

MAINSRING LARGE MEETING ROOM

\$30,000

Collaboration is at the heart of Mainspring's work. This meeting room will support our efforts, providing the space for our agencies to come together to support one another and shared clients as well as to brainstorm ideas for how we can enhance and improvise processes and programs going forward. Beyond the Mainspring partners, the meeting room will be open for other agencies and programs to use.

Recognition OPPORTUNITIES

FOOTPRINTS FOOD PREP STATION

\$25,000

Each week, Footprints rescues food from local grocers and is fortunate enough to receive donations from local farms. It is in this food prep station that Footprints' volunteers glean through rescue food and prep donated produce for our food distribution. In this space, countless community volunteers lend their time on a weekly basis to support the needs of the community.

COMMUNITY GARDEN BEDS (4 available)

\$10,000 each

This key component of any food system will provide clients with fresh produce and the opportunity for a garden space of their own. Cooperation and coordination between gardens, farms, retail stores, nutritious food processors and restaurants can help reduce food waste, increase local production and provide more food for our community.

THRIFT STORE SHELVING (10 available)

\$5,000 each

The new Fair Tide thrift store will consist of 2,300 square feet of shopping space. The layout will include both stationary and movable shelving to allow for flexibility in store displays and open up possibilities for selling larger furniture donations, which our current location does not allow for. All of the improvements will grow this critical revenue stream to enhance Fair Tide's housing programs.

REFRIGERATED LOCKERS (4 available)

\$2,500 each

For many individuals and families, busy schedules prevent them from visiting the pantry during open hours. Thanks to refrigerated lockers, clients can place an order ahead of time and food will be stored in one of the lockers which can be picked up at the client's convenience. We strive to remove all barriers to accessing food, ensuring all individuals are able to receive fresh food in a personalized manner.
